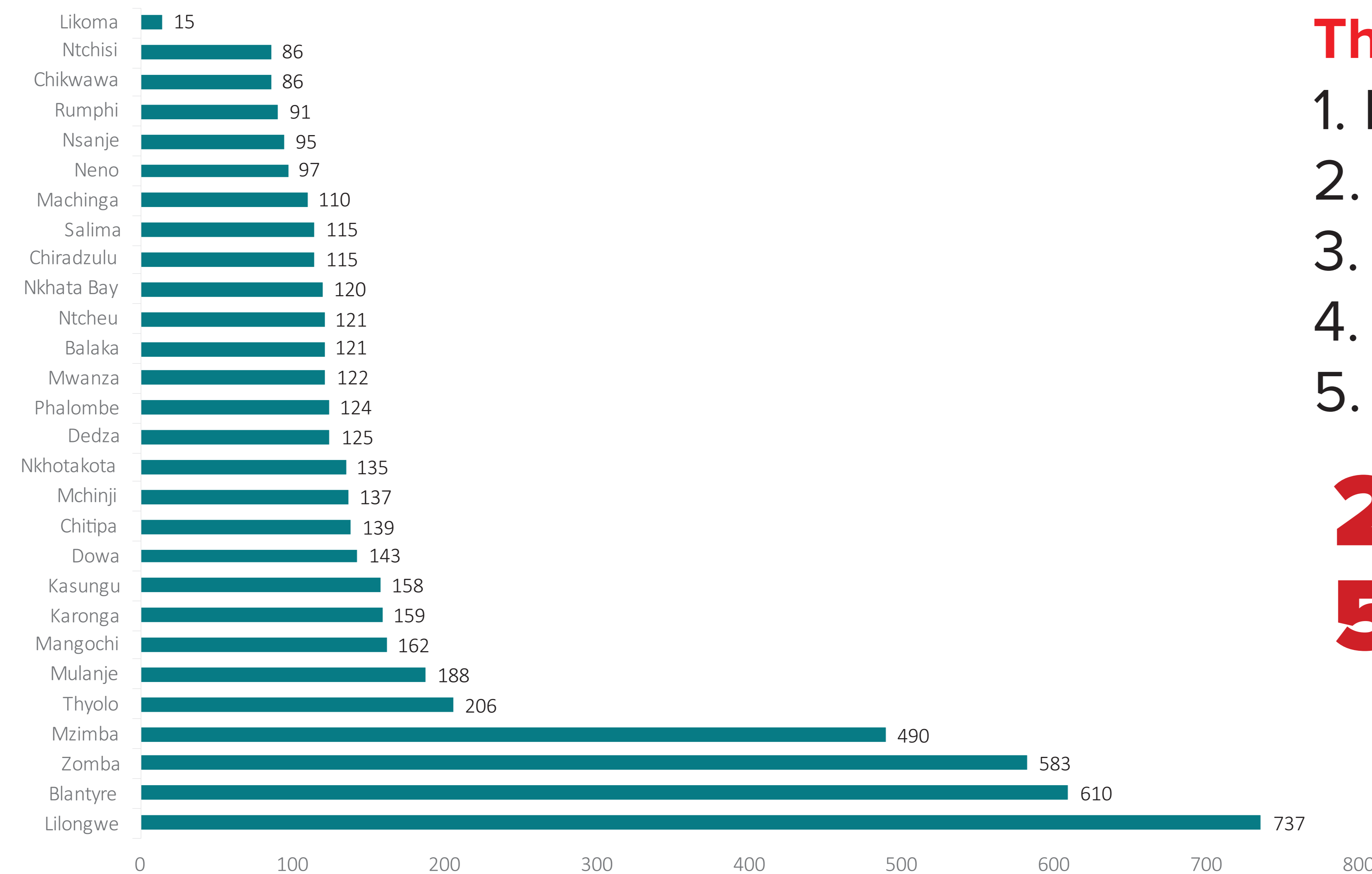


What Midwives Want - Malawi

White Ribbon Alliance Malawi in conjunction with Association of Malawian Midwives (AMAMI) and National Organization of Nurses and Midwives (NONM) engaged midwives across Malawi to state their demands for them to do their work better. The study received overwhelming response from the midwives. Over 5,000 midwives responded.

The top fives demands were as follows:

1. Equipment and Supplies – 1,765 (32%)
2. Remuneration – 1,447 (27%)
3. Professional development – 821 (15%)
4. Staffing - 431 (8%)
5. Improved infrastructure – 279 (5%)
